## Room Panel with speech

CareTech's Room Panel with speech is designed for permanent mounting on a wall, for example in the room of a resident in sheltered accommodation. The resident can easily call staff by pressing the red alarm button. The room panel can also be connected to various types of individually tailored, wired or wireless alarm sensors, or to individual triggers or pendant pushbuttons placed in locations where the individual often spends time, such as at a bedside or by a favourite armchair.

Staff can respond to the alarm by telephone, which automatically establishes a speech link with the resident. When staff arrive they confirm their presence and reset the alarm by pressing the green button. While they are in the room staff can also monitor the alarm status continuously and see if other residents or staff require assistance. The room panel is easily connected to CareTech's nurse and warden call system and other types of alarm transmitters.



## Room Panel with speech

- Two-way speech.
- Easy to install and operate. Can be programmed locally or using Omni Central Unit, or via the Internet.
- Interactive radio receivers in each room give radio coverage throughout building.
- Units with and without speech can be combined in same system.
- Intelligent, programmable and addressable display.
- Three inputs, closing/opening.
- Door alarm function with adjustable times and bypass for staff use.
- One output, e.g. for lamp outside door.
- Passive alarm if event does not occur.
- Filter shows own department's alarms during day and several departments' alarms at night.
- Alphanumeric information consisting of up to 9 characters displayed in conjunction with alarm.
- Can be mounted in Thorsman trunking.
- Radio triggers work as normal throughout accommodation. If required, two radio triggers can be programmed to work only with a specific room panel.
- Many different ID settings (display text "room") can be entered, such as floor, area, department, bed, etc.
- Many parameters can be set, such as language, control of buzzer and fire alarm display.
